EDC Incentive Programs

Quick Notes

SCORE/EDC Microloan Program

Provides for:

- \$2,500 \$10,000 micro-loan.
- 36 Months (3 years) term.
- Rates are below Prime.

Business Requirements:

- \$45 Application Fee
- Resident of Citrus County.
- No liens or judgments.
- No bankruptcies.
- Must attend SCORE counseling.

Funding Sources:

• Banks donate funds for the program.

Default Actions:

If recipient fails to continually pay monthly or files bankruptcy the following action is taken:

- Administrative Assistant contacts recipient.
- Attorney contacts recipient.
- Loan goes to collections.

Process:

Application →SCORE →EDC Micro-Loan Committee →Credit check •lobbies banks for funds →Bank donates
 \$ to EDC →Fund dispersed to recipient → EDC tracks payments for the life of the loan

Economic Development Incentive Program

Provides for:

• Potential ad valorem tax relief for up to 10 years

Business Requirements:

- Targeted Industries Eligibility Requirement: Manufacturing, Agriculture, Resource Recovery/Recycling,
 Technology Development and Medical/Biomedical. Specifically excluded from eligibility are retail, office,
 storage, warehouse or speculative investment properties.
- New Business: 25 full-time jobs (or part-time equivalent)
 - Job creation within 1 year of project completion.
 - Job maintained for 1 year.
- Existing Business: 12 full-time jobs (or part-time equivalent)
 - o Job creation within 1 year of project completion.
 - Job maintained for 1 year.
- Salaries of created jobs must be 115% more than the average wage in Citrus County.
- Construct \$500,000 worth of capital improvements.
- Must provide documentation verifying jobs maintained after 1 year. Upon approval of package, a Grant
 Agreement between BOCC and recipient allows for a lien to be placed upon the property until job creation has
 been verified.

Default Actions:

If jobs or salary pledges are not met the following actions are taken:

Tax relief is withdrawn and monies returned.

Process:

 Application → Executive Board → Board of Directors → BOCC → BOCC creates a Resolution and designates number of years of tax relief • BOCC creates fore mentioned Grant Agreement → EDC monitors applicant for compliance

Utility Expansion Program

Provides for:

• Funding assistance for hydrant installation and infrastructure installation, such as sewer and water lines, including engineering and clearance costs.

Business Requirements:

- Targeted Industries Eligibility Requirement: Manufacturing, Agriculture, Resource Recovery/Recycling,
 Technology Development and Medical/Biomedical. Specifically excluded from eligibility are retail, office,
 storage, warehouse or speculative investment properties.
- Creation of 15 full time jobs (or part-time equivalent) within 1 year of utility project completion.
- Jobs maintained for 1 year.
- Must provide documentation verifying jobs maintained after 1 year. Upon approval of package, a Grant
 Agreement between BOCC and recipient allows for a lien to be placed upon the property until job creation has
 been verified.

Utility Requirements:

• Must commit to reimbursing the off-site improvement fees to the O.L. fund within 30 days of connection by others who benefit from the installation of utilities.

Funding Source:

- Business License Fund (B.L. Fund)
 - o Proposed project shall not exceed \$250,000 from the B.L. Fund.
 - o Within 3 years of completion 25% of contribution from the B.L. Fund shall be collected and returned.
 - Property owner is responsible to ensure that 80% of the contribution from the B.L. Fund be recovered within 10 years of project completion.

Default Actions:

If jobs or salary pledges are not met the following actions are taken:

- Applicant reimburses the B.L. Fund on a pro-rata basis within 90 days of the extension activation.
- Failure of above mentioned reimbursement shall result in the foreclosure of the lien.

Process:

• Application → Executive Board → Board of Directors → BOCC → BOCC creates Grant Agreement with recipient Funds released to Utility → Servicing Utility reimburses the B.L.Fund → EDC monitors applicant for compliance

Job Growth Incentive Grant Program

Provides for:

- \$2000.00 per job created. (EDC can request more per job for approval from the BOCC.)
 - o Grant monies can only be used for the following expenses:
 - Payment of impact fee and special assessments.
 - Water and sewer connection fees.
 - Maximum award \$100,000. (EDC and BOCC can award more.)

Business Requirements:

- Creation of 5 or more full-time (or part-time equivalent) non-retail jobs.
 - o Job creation must be done within the agreed upon time frame.
 - Jobs need to be maintained for 1 year.
- Salaries of created jobs must be 10% more than the average salary in Citrus County.
- Applies to relocation of a business or expansion of an existing business or start-up business.
- Majority of revenue from outside of Citrus County or provide product or service not provided in Citrus County.
- Upon approval, applicant has 90 days to finalize a contract. Award nullified if a contract is not completed.

Funding Source:

- EDC Private Account
- Business License Fund

Process:

Application \rightarrow Executive Board \rightarrow Board of Directors \rightarrow BOCC \rightarrow BOCC creates Grant Agreement with recipient \rightarrow Funds released to applicant \rightarrow EDC monitors applicant for compliance for life of the agreement.

Medical Recruitment Incentive Program

Provides for:

Potential ad valorem tax relief for medical equipment subject to local tangible tax

Business Requirements:

- New Business: 10 full-time jobs
- Job creation within 1 year of project completion
- Job maintained at least 1 year
- Existing Business: 10 additional full time jobs
- Job creation within 1 year of project completion
- Job maintained at least 1 year
- Salaries of created jobs must be 115% more than the average wage in Citrus County
- Construct \$100,000 worth of capital improvements
- Must provide documentation verifying jobs maintained after 1 year. Upon approval of package, a Grant
 Agreement between BOCC and recipient allows lien to be placed upon the property until job creation has been
 verified

Default Actions:

Local Small Business Assistance Program

Provides for:

- Potential funding assistance for payment for local small businesses, within targeted industries, of County and City permitting and licensing fees
- Water and Sewer connection or expansion fees

Business Requirements:

- Targeted Industries Eligibility Requirement: Manufacturing, Agriculture, Resource Recovery/Recycling,
 Technology Development and Medical/Biomedical. Specifically excluded from eligibility are retail, office,
 storage, warehouse or speculative investment properties.
- New Business : 5 full-time jobs
- Job creation within 1 year of project completion
- Job maintained at least 1 year
- Existing Business: 5 additional full time jobs or 50% greater than the prior retained staffing level, whichever is greater
- Job creation within 1 year of project completion
- Job maintained at least 1 year
- Salaries of created jobs must be 115% more than the average wage in Citrus County
- Construct \$100,000 worth of capital improvements
- Must provide documentation verifying jobs maintained after 1 year. Upon approval of package, a Grant
 Agreement between BOCC and recipient allows lien to be placed upon the property until job creation has been
 verified

Default Actions:

If jobs or salary pledges are not met the following actions are taken:

• Tax relief is withdrawn and monies returned.

Process for utility connection or expansion:

• Application → Executive Board → Board of Directors → BOCC → BOCC creates Grant Agreement with recipient Funds released to Utility → Servicing Utility reimburses the B.L.Fund → EDC monitors applicant for compliance

Process for other fee assistance:

Application \rightarrow Executive Board \rightarrow Board of Directors \rightarrow BOCC \rightarrow BOCC creates Grant Agreement with recipient \rightarrow Funds released to applicant \rightarrow EDC monitors applicant for compliance for life of the agreement.

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
